Interlam Corporation announces change to finishing option.

Interlam Corporation announces today that they will no longer offer High Gloss and Non-Gloss Foil membrane finishes on fire rated MDF core material.

Interlam's VP of Operations, Eddie Bishop says, "We want to make sure that the finished product is exactly what the customer desires and unfortunately there is a problem with the adherence to the fire rated board by the adhesive and the membrane foil. We are working with the board manufacturer as well as with the membrane supplier to find a solution".

Interlam is the leading manufacturer of architectural wall panels and components. Their products include wall panels under Art Diffusion, Elements, Super Rock, and Motion lines as well as architectural components under the Screens, Laminated Glass Systems, Mirage, and Micro Thin Slate lines. The company sells its products through certified distributors and direct representatives throughout the world.

Interlam has conducted several tests using its various patterns carved into fire rated board, the adhesive, and different membrane finishes. The results were unsatisfactory. They were also advised by their current adhesive supplier to cease its offerings of membrane foils on fire rated cores due to this issue.

No date has been determined as to when this issue will be resolved.
